Daysland Town Council Notes

- Council held their annual Organizational Meeting on Sept. 29 making appointments to various boards and committees and the following nominations:
 - ♦ Mayor – Lin Lawson
 - ♦ Deputy Mayor – Sherri Grove
 - ♦ Acting Mayor – Nick Saik
 - ♦ Councillor – Jim Martin
 - ♦ Councillor – June Serediak
- Council discussed a detailed medical clinic building condition assessment prepared by Banner Engineering to work towards making a decision on a long-term medical clinic option.
- No residential lots were sold at the September 30 deadline. Council established pricing for the lots at the reserve bid prices for Crocus Meadows and the Golf Course lots and the lots will be sold on a first come, first served basis.
- Council heard a delegation from Associated Engineering recommending a new water treatment plant.
- Council lifted the lawn watering ban as follows:
 - Odd Days ~ East of 50th Street
 - Even Days ~ West of 50th Street
- Council discussed the taxation concerns of the Daysland Business Association.
- Council approved the replacement of a manhole on 46th Street.
- Council approved the hosting of a volunteer appreciation Christmas party on November 28. See the insert for details!

Public Works Notes

- The water and sewer line replacement project is progressing well on 47th Street. Homeowners on 48th Street, between 50th and 51st Avenue, are asked to ensure that their outside water faucet is working in order to hookup temporary water lines. All roads affected by this construction will be resurfaced once all underground construction is completed.
- The water meter installation project is scheduled to begin October 26. Watch for correspondence from Neptune Technology Group in your mail within the next 2 weeks. Residents must call the booking number by November 9 to schedule a water meter install.
- Water isolation valves have been installed at various locations on the water main line to enable water shut offs to specific areas, rather than affecting the entire town.

Fire Fighter Notes

In August three of our volunteer fire fighters took the S600 course in Camrose, which enables them to operate the fire truck / pumper more efficiently. This course replaces the Pumper A course.

Our volunteer fire fighters attended two fires in September, one in the ditch on Hwy 855 and the other involved seven ditch fires on Hwy 13.

Fire Ban

The Town of Daysland has issued a Fire Ban that includes: open fires, burning barrels and fire pits.

This ban excludes: propane and natural gas barbeques.
